- Called to order by president, Susan Sears
- **Principal's Report-Mr. Boedicker**
 - Link Crew-Student driven-students caring for students
 - FLOTS have traveled with two groups of elementary students. 10 FLOTS went to Flat Rock camp and 25 to Bradford Woods.
 - Transportation-still working on logistics of drop off. It would be helpful if all vehicles moved forward to door 6 to drop off.
