T ime	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Arrive prepared with all materials.2. Stay on task.3. Be ready to start class when the bell rings.4. Follow teacher directions the first time.
O thers	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Positive feedback only.2. Be kind, be positive.3. Keep hands, feet and objects to yourself.4. Listen when others are speaking.
P roperty	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Use materials for intended use only.2. Take pride in school property and supplies and leave the classroom in better condition than you found it.3. Be prepared with your own materials.4. Only touch your own things.
S elf	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Make positive decisions.2. Be responsible for your actions.3. Stay in dress code.4. Be ready to learn.

Classroom Routines/Behavior Expectations	
Starting the Class	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Come in quietly and sit in your assigned seat 2. Be seated by the time the bell rings
Classroom Movement (Sharpening pencils, etc.)	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Quietly sharpen pencils, then go back to your desk 2. Trash can wait at your desk until the end of the period 3. If you need a moment to stretch or walk around, do it without disrupting others
Ending the Class	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Log out of the computer 2. Keyboard back on top of computer 3. Chair pushed in
Working Independently	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Stay on task 2. Work quietly 3. Use your time wisely- don't waste time 4. You receive 3 strikes for talking/not following directions- after that, consequences
Working in Groups	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Everyone needs to be an active participant 2. Be respectful of others voices and opinions

Asking for Help	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Raise your hand2. DO NOT BLURT3. See 3 before me (ask a neighbor)
Transition Procedures	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Pay attention to and follow directions2. Move like a mouse (quietly)
Obtaining Materials/Supplies	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. When you come in, get your lesson pacing guide
Completing & Returning Work	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Place your lesson pacing guides in the appropriate tray daily
Passes (Request to leave the room)	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Passes can be given after the first 5 minutes to the last 10 minutes of class.2. Only if it is a TRUE EMERGENCY- not if you just need to walk around
Ending the Class	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Sign out of the computer2. Place your keyboard back on your computer3. Stand up, push in your chair
