<b>RESPECT</b>	<b><i>RULE NUMBER ONE - IF YOU DO THE FOLLOWING, EVERYTHING ELSE WILL BE EASY!</i></b>
<b>T</b> ime	<ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. Arrive prepared with all materials.</li><li>2. Stay on task.</li><li>3. Be ready to start class when the bell rings.</li><li>4. Follow teacher directions the first time.</li></ol>
<b>O</b> thers	<ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. Positive feedback only.</li><li>2. Be kind, be positive.</li><li>3. Keep hands, feet and objects to yourself.</li><li>4. Listen when others are speaking.</li></ol>
<b>P</b> roperty	<ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. Use materials for intended use only.</li><li>2. Take pride in school property and supplies and leave the classroom in better condition than you found it.</li><li>3. Be prepared with your own materials.</li><li>4. Only touch your own things.</li></ol>
<b>S</b> elf	<ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. Make positive decisions.</li><li>2. Be responsible for your actions.</li><li>3. Stay in dress code.</li><li>4. Be ready to learn.</li></ol>

## Classroom Routines/Behavior Expectations

<b>Starting the Class</b>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. All students should be in their seat and working on Bell Work when the bell rings.</li> <li>2. If you finish the daily Bell Work before the allotted time is up, you should sit quietly at your seat.</li> <li>3. As students arrive, they will place Chromebooks under their desks and not get on them until told to do so by Mrs. Orr.</li> </ol>
<b>Classroom Movement (Sharpening pencils, etc.)</b>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Students should have pencils sharpened and all required materials before the bell rings.</li> <li>2. No Sharpening when the teacher is teaching.</li> <li>3. Quietly get other supplies if needed, without disrupting the class.</li> </ol>
<b>Attention Signal</b>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. When Mrs. Orr starts talking, all student conversations should stop.</li> </ol>
<b>Working Independently</b>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Independent work should be done without the help of your neighbor.</li> <li>2. If you have a question, please raise your hand and either myself or another teacher will come over to assist you.</li> <li>3. Independent work should be done quietly.</li> </ol>
<b>Working in Groups</b>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Noise during group work should be kept to an acceptable level.</li> <li>2. The leader of the group, assigned by the teacher, should keep the group on task.</li> <li>3. All students are expected to participate.</li> <li>4. If your group has a question, one person from your group should raise his or her hand. Myself or another teacher will come to your group to assist.</li> </ol>
<b>Asking for Help</b>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Never be afraid to ask for help.</li> <li>2. Raise your hand and I will come to over to assist you.</li> <li>3. During group/partner work, be sure to ask your group members before asking me.</li> <li>4. Should a question arise after you have left my room for the day, email me and I will respond as soon as possible. (<a href="mailto:aorr@perryschools.org">aorr@perryschools.org</a>)</li> </ol>
<b>Transition Procedures</b>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. All transitions should be done quietly and in a timely manner immediately following instructions.</li> </ol>

<b>Obtaining Materials/Supplies</b>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. All the materials you will need for class each day should be on your desk when you arrive, or will be passed out at the appropriate time.</li> <li>2. If you notice that you are missing an item, please raise your hand and I will get it for you.</li> <li>3. If you are absent, please be sure to check the folders on the, "While You Were Out," board for notes over lessons.</li> </ol>
<b>Completing &amp; Returning Work</b>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. All work should be of High Quality: All work must be shown. Work must be neat and organized. All steps must be completed. Your answer is correct.</li> <li>2. Please be sure that your name, the date, and your class period are included on any assignment that you turn in.</li> </ol>
<b>Passes (Request to leave the room)</b>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. You must use your own passes in your agenda.</li> <li>2. If you need to use a pass, please raise your hand.</li> <li>3. Passes will not be given during instruction time unless it is an absolute emergency.</li> </ol>
<b>Ending the Class</b>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Place exit tickets in the correct tray before leaving the room.</li> <li>2. All supplies should be left like you found them.</li> <li>3. Desks should be in order and all garbage should be picked up off of the floor around you.</li> <li>4. Remain in your seat until I dismiss you.</li> </ol>
<b>Substitute Teachers</b>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Any student's name that is left from a substitute teacher for disruption or misbehaving will result in an automatic SCR.</li> </ol>
<b>Classroom Environment</b>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. All students will treat the classroom and those in it respectfully.</li> <li>2. Students will give their best effort and attitude on all work/activities.</li> <li>3. Students will own their education and behavior.</li> </ol>
<b>Chromebooks</b>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Chromebooks are for educational purposes only.</li> <li>2. Once students have logged into Question Press, computers should be placed under their desk and not opened again until told to do so.</li> <li>3. During "free time" after daily quizzes, students may only visit pre-approved websites.</li> <li>4. Earbuds should not be used unless instructed to do so</li> </ol>
