T ime	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Arrive prepared with all materials.2. Stay on task.3. Be ready to start class when the bell rings.4. Follow teacher directions the first time.
O thers	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Positive feedback only.2. Be kind, be positive.3. Keep hands, feet and objects to yourself.4. Listen when others are speaking.
P roperty	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Use materials for intended use only.2. Take pride in school property and supplies and leave the classroom in better condition than you found it.3. Be prepared with your own materials.4. Only touch your own things.
S elf	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Make positive decisions.2. Be responsible for your actions.3. Stay in dress code.4. Be ready to learn.

Classroom Routines/Behavior Expectations

Starting the Class	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Grab the papers on the front table.2. Go to your seat and wait for the bell to ring.3. Get your folders from the back of the room and place papers in the appropriate spot.4. Once the bell rings, Mr. Vogl will greet the class and begin working on bell work.
Classroom Movement (Sharpening pencils, etc.)	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Raise your hand and ask before sharpening pencils.2. Trash can wait at your desk until the end of the period. If you must throw something away, do so quickly and quietly without interrupting class.3. Raise your hand and ask for a tissue.4. No shooting baskets when throwing something away. This is major distraction will automatically result in a SCR.5. You must clean up after yourself before leaving class.
Attention Signal	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. "Eyes on me"- Everyone should be quietly looking at me ready to move on to the next activity.2. "Hands-Free"- You need to stop what you are working on, put down any supplies, and wait for Mr. Vogl to give more instructions.
Working Independently	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Stay on task.2. Work quietly.3. Eyes on your own paper, no sharing answers.4. Use your time wisely- don't waste it!
Working in Groups	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Stay in your group and at your station- no wandering around the room or talking to other groups/people.2. Everyone needs to be an active participant. Not one person should be doing all the work!3. Be respectful of others voices and opinions.4. Follow all directions given.

Asking for Help	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Raise your hand. 2. Ask a neighbor quietly first. Do not have off topic conversations with them! 3. Don't follow Mr. Vogl around repeating his name. 4. Don't blurt answers out. Mr. Vogl will prompt class when an answer can be said aloud. 5. If you need extra help outside of class time ask me.
Transition Procedures	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Move quickly with your materials. 2. Stay quiet the whole time unless instructed otherwise.
Obtaining Materials/Supplies	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Move quickly gathering your supplies. 2. Stay quiet to not disturb others. 3. Return everything borrowed from Mr. Vogl. 4. Treat all the supplies with respect! 5. Any misuse of supplies can result in a SCR.
Completing & Returning Work	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Papers will need to go into your folder. Make sure you follow the order as listed on the board. 2. Folders will be collected, graded using a rubric, and returned to students. Assignments may also be collected individually. 3. Some assignments may require online submission through Canvas. 4. Grades will be posted on Skyward. Tests and quizzes will be posted on both Canvas and Skyward. 5. Any work not completed in class becomes homework. 6. ALL work is the students responsibility to complete. 7. Late work can be turned in for 50% of the total grade.
Passes (Request to leave the room)	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Passes can be given after the first 5 minutes to the last 10 minutes of class. 2. Passes must come from your agenda with your name on it. I will not write passes in agendas that have the name scribbled out. 3. Only if it is a TRUE EMERGENCY- not if you just need to walk around. 4. Passes will be signed at the teachers discretion. Do not ask for a pass while I am teaching.

Quizzes/Tests	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Follow ALL instructions given on tests and quizzes.2. Come prepared with your Chromebook. Most of our tests and quizzes will be conducted through Canvas.3. Be respectful and quiet throughout the testing time. If you are talking I assume your cheating and an SCR will be given.4. Eyes should remain on your own computer screen. All tabs should be closed and there should no be any reason to visit other websites.
Electronic Devices	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Chromebooks should be brought to class each day. Earbuds may also be brought but should not be used unless otherwise instructed.2. Per school policy, all electronic devices (phones, ipods, Apple watches, etc.) are to be turned off and stored in your locker.3. All online activity is monitored and any misuse will be reported to student services.4. Teacher reserves the right to confiscate any electronic device that is not allowed or misused in class.
Ending the Class	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Make sure your papers are in the right spot in your folder.2. Put your name on everything!3. Clean up desk and floor around you. Even if the mess is not yours it should be picked up.4. I will dismiss you not the bell.
