- Central Nine vocational/technical school participant

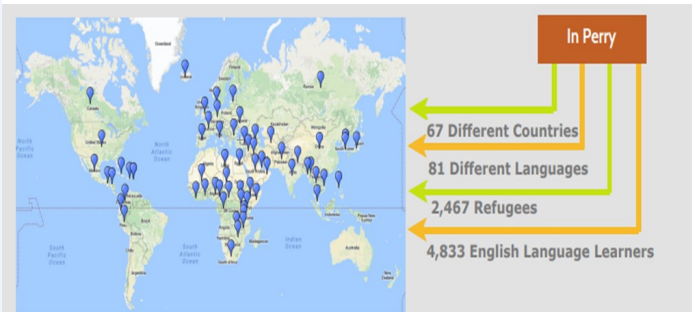
District Information

Compensation and Development

- Beginning salary for teachers: \$42,500 (BA + 0 years)
- Opportunity to earn additional compensation (\$2,000-\$6,000 annually) for teacher effectiveness
- Health insurance option for \$1.00 per year with employer HSA contribution
- Wellness program & incentives
- Employer paid life and long-term disability insurance
- Short-term disability, accident, hospitalization, and critical illness benefits available
- TRF and 401 (a) paid teacher retirement plan + HRA account
- 10 sick days and 5 personal days annually
