A MESSAGE FROM THE SUPERINTENDENT

Dear Perry Township Community,

We have an exciting year ahead filled with new opportunities, academic growth, meaningful friendships, and plenty of memorable experiences along the way.

One of the most exciting developments this year is the launch of our new [entrepreneurship and innovation center on the campus of the University of Indianapolis](#). Opening this fall in its temporary location, the program will provide students from both Perry Meridian and Southport High Schools with an immersive, career-connected learning experience. Students will be transported to UIndy's campus, where they will engage in hands-on learning designed to prepare them for future careers and success beyond high school.

We are also excited to unveil the transformation of Holder Field. The facility now features two new turf fields, with grass currently growing on two additional baseball and softball fields. Upgraded dugouts, concession stands, and other improvements have created a first-class experience for our student-athletes and the community.

Last school year, we began implementing our [District Strategic Plan](#), which focuses on four key priorities:

- **Initiative 1:** Improving academic performance
- **Initiative 2:** Fostering a positive school climate
- **Initiative 3:** Strengthening relationships with parents, guardians, and the community
- **Initiative 4:** Prioritizing transparency in financial management

I am pleased to report that we are seeing positive results in each of these areas. Here are just a few examples of our progress:

- **Initiative 1 Update:** Academic achievement continues to improve, including an increase in the IREAD-3 passage rate compared to the previous year.
- **Initiative 2 Update:** Every school in the district is now utilizing Onflo (formerly Let's Talk), making it easier than ever for families and community members to share feedback, ask questions, and communicate with our schools.
- **Initiative 3 Update:** We established an 18-member Community Advisory Board made up of local residents, business leaders, and community organizations. This group will work alongside district leadership to support and enhance educational opportunities for our students.
- **Initiative 4 Update:** We celebrated the reopening of Holder Field with a community ribbon-cutting ceremony, highlighting our commitment to providing outstanding facilities for students and families. Additionally, Perry Township Schools earned the highest possible rating in its most recent financial audit, demonstrating our continued commitment to responsible stewardship of taxpayer resources.

I am grateful for the progress we achieved together last year, but our work is far from finished. We will continue building on these successes, keeping student growth and achievement at the center of everything we do – because in Perry Township Schools we grow kids. Thank you for your continued support of Perry Township Schools. Together, we will make the 2026-27 school year one of our best yet.

COMMUNITY ELIGIBILITY PROVISION

Perry Township Schools will continue to participate in the national school lunch and breakfast program called the Community Eligibility Provision (CEP) for the 26-27 school year. Through the CEP, all students will receive a healthy breakfast and lunch at school at no charge to the student. À la carte food purchases and additional meals are not included in this program and will incur a charge. When a student's account has a negative balance, no charges will be allowed for à la carte items.

PAYMENT PROCESS

All students have a school meal account for pre-payments that is to be used for à la carte purchases in the cafeteria during the 26-27 school year. To make a payment, choose an option below:

1. To pay online by using e-Funds, log into perryschools.org
2. Select Lunch/Fee payment link at the top right of the screen, and log in to e-Funds for schools
3. You may send cash or check to the school cafeteria. If you send a check or cash with your child, you MUST place it in a sealed envelope and write your child's complete name, student ID number, and amount enclosed in the envelope. No change will be given at the register.

ASSISTANCE

At Perry Township Schools we strive to provide access and resources that benefit all students. Although meals and textbooks are free this year, we HIGHLY encourage families to still fill out the assistance application on Skyward. Completing this application ensures the district receives all eligible funding to support students. Families who feel they qualify based on the income eligibility chart below should apply. Applications will open in **August**. Please fill out an application before **September 1**. For the most rapid processing of your application, please apply on Skyward.

Perry Township Schools will not charge families for textbooks for the 2026-27 school year. However, outstanding charges from previous years will still be billed. Additionally, any lost or damaged materials will be billed. Both of these payments can be paid through our e-Funds system.

HepB: The minimum age for the third dose of Hepatitis B is 24 weeks of age.

DTaP: Four doses of DTaP/DTP/DT are acceptable if fourth dose was administered on or after the fourth birthday.

Polio*: Three doses of Polio are acceptable for all grade levels if the third dose was given on or after the fourth birthday and at least six months after the previous dose. *For students in grades K-12, the final dose must be administered on or after the fourth birthday and be administered at least six months after the previous dose.

Varicella: Physician documentation of disease history, including month and year, is proof of immunity for children entering preschool through 12th grade. Parent report of disease history is not acceptable.

Tdap: There is no minimum interval from the last Td dose.

MCV4: Individuals who receive their first dose on or after their 16th birthday only need one dose of MCV4.

Hepatitis A: The minimum interval between first and second dose is six calendar months. Two doses are required for all grade levels.
