Tour your student's building and see their classrooms.



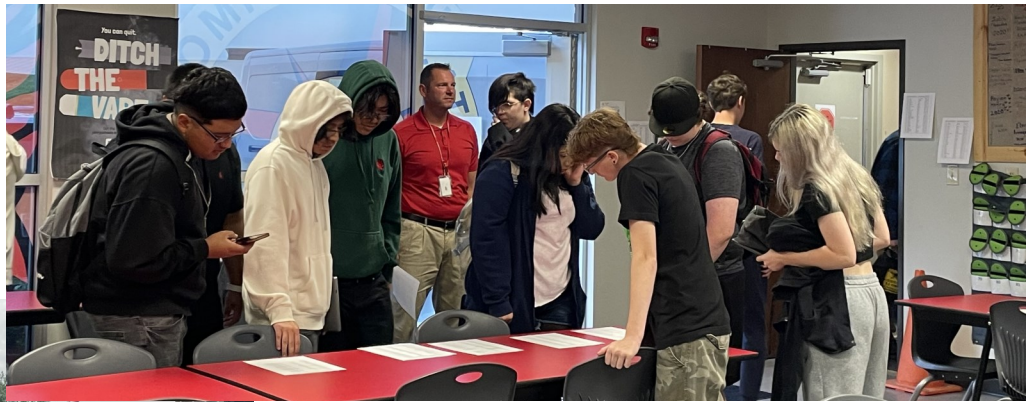

Craig's Corner

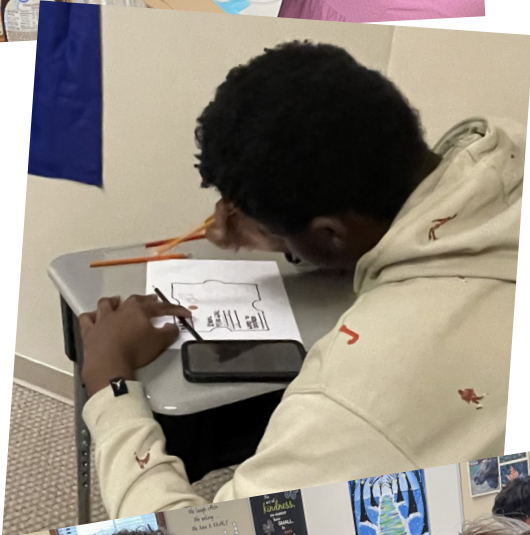
