FAFSA Application Day:

Our next FAFSA enrollment date is March 13th at 8:00 am and 12:00 pm. Parents are welcome to join their seniors during this application day.

There are many students who have incomplete applications. Please ask your student to login into StudentAid.gov and, if needed, complete and submit the needed information.

Things that you can do before this date are:

Log in to your StudentAid.gov account (FSA ID)

Create a student login

<u>Determine dependency status</u>. Note: Most students will be considered dependent students. Students who are considered "dependent students" will be required to include their parent's (they're called "contributors" on the FAFSA) financial information on the FAFSA. See who is considered a contributor.

Parents will also need to create a StudentAid.gov account username and password.

Then, log in at StudentAid.gov to make sure you're all set.

We require all seniors to file the FAFSA so that all doors are open no matter what the student decides to pursue in the 2025-2026 school year.

Graduation Information

Hello!

It's that time of year to order your graduation cap and gown and tassel. This is a package and this the minimum you need to get in order to participate in graduation. please look at the information based on your homeschool.

Southport High School:

Families are also able to order online at <u>Jostens.com</u>. There are a lot of items available to purchase, but the <u>ONLY thing you MUST order</u> if you plan to participate in the graduation ceremony is the cap, gown and tassel. This is called the "Cap & Gown Unit" which costs \$39. All students need to wear the Jostens red cap and gown with the 2025 tassel in order to participate in the SHS graduation ceremony on Friday, May 30th. All other items from Jostens are optional for you to order.

The gown is a rental and will be returned immediately after commencement, but the cap/tassel you keep forever.

You may order directly from the website at: <u>PERRY MERIDIAN HIGH SCH | Herff Jones</u> Remember, the only items you must purchase for graduation are the cap/gown/tassel.

The total cost with tax is \$49.22 (the website will say \$46 because that is before taxes are added). You will have an opportunity to order a variety of different packages/graduation items.
