
Furthermore, Pete Fasano, the camp director, will be presenting exciting information about camp activities, dining, facilities, safety, etc.

2025-2026 Kindergarten Registration Information

Kindergarten registration will begin on January 6, 2025 for those students who will be entering Kindergarten in the Fall of 2025. The student must turn **5 years old on or before August 1, 2025** in order to register. There is a waiver process for children with a birthdate after August 1st up to August 15th. Contact the school for information. The Kindergarten Academy your student will attend is determined by your residence only and not where other siblings may be attending.
