MEDICATION POLICY

Medication can be administered at school. The following rules apply to prescription and non-prescription medications:

1. Medication must be provided by the student's parent or guardian and must be in the original container as supplied by the pharmacist or, in the case of OCT (over the counter) medications, brought in with the manufacturer's original label with the ingredients listed and the student's name affixed to the original package.
2. Written parent permission and instruction regarding dosage, time and frequency of administration. Parent permission shall be renewed at the beginning of each school year.
3. The parent or guardian is responsible at the end of the treatment regime for removing from the school any unused medication which was prescribed for his/her child. If the parent does not pick up the medication by the end of the school year, the school nurse will dispose of and document that medication was discarded.
4. Students may not have medications in their possession while on school premises without written permission of a parent or guardian, written authorization of the student's physician, and, in the case of a prescription drug, a written prescription of a licensed medical practitioner authorized to prescribe the particular drug.
