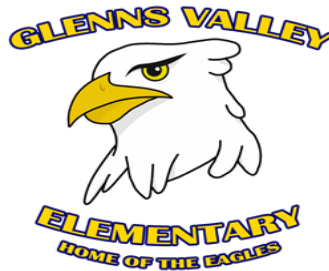

IMPORTANT PARENT INFORMATION!

Going into the 2019-20 school year, it is critical that we can stay in touch with you. In order to do this, we must have a good e-mail address on file for you. If you utilize Skyward currently and have a good e-mail address on file, thank you! If you believe you already have an e-mail address on file but have never logged into Skyward, please do so using the Forgot Login/Password? prompt on our Skyward page. If you have any problems, please contact your child's school for assistance and to provide them with a good e-mail address.

New Kindergarten Eligibility Dates

On Monday, April 29, 2019, Gov. Eric Holcomb signed a bill that changes the eligibility cutoff date for students entering kindergarten in the 2019-20 school year. If your child will turn 5 on or before Sept. 1, 2019, you are eligible to apply for kindergarten. Previously, a child was eligible for kindergarten in the fall of 2019 if they turned 5 on or before Aug. 1, 2019.

End of the year Negative Food Service Balance Information

At the end of the school year, any negative food balances of more than \$50.00 will be sent to a professional collection agency. The negative balance stays with the student's account until graduation or upon withdrawal. Graduating seniors must pay all charges in full. Failure to do so may result in not being allowed to participate in the graduation ceremonies. Payments can be made in person with your student's front office staff or through the Child Nutrition Department by contacting Janet Nataren at 317-789-3738 or Teresa Stinnett at 317-789-3741. Payments may also be made online through e-funds, but please note that no payments will be accepted through e-funds between Monday, June 17th through Friday, June 28th due to a system update. In-person payments will also not be accepted Monday, June 17th and Tuesday, June 18th due to this update.

A note about student medications: If your child has medication(s) in the clinic, please plan to pick them up by Friday 5/24/19 at 11:30am. Any medication(s) that are not retrieved will be discarded. Per School Board Policy 5330, medications for students in grades K - 8 "may be released only to the student's parent/guardian or to an individual who is eighteen (18) years of age or older and who has been designated, in writing, by the student's parent/guardian to receive the medication." Any emergency medications, including inhalers and EpiPens, should not be picked up until the last day of school. We appreciate your cooperation!
