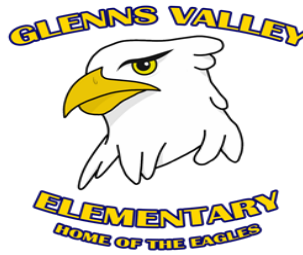

The Glens Valley Student Council will be sponsoring a fundraiser for an organization called **Pack Away Hunger**. The fundraiser will take place for three weeks beginning on Monday, February 10th and ending on Friday, February 28th.

Pack Away Hunger is a non-profit organization that is dedicated to greatly improving the lives of children and others who suffer from hunger and malnutrition. It affects 15.8 million children in the United States and 1 out of 6 children in developing countries. The lack of proper nutrition creates serious health and development consequences for children.

The students will be collecting money, so that we may pack 3,000 to 4,000 Nutri-Plenty Meals. Each meal contains a blend of 21 vitamins and minerals. They also contain a healthy mixture of rice, soy, vegetables, and flavorings. The meal is easy for families to prepare, requiring only a pot of boiling water and a spoon. Each meal costs only \$0.30 to prepare, so donating \$1.00 will pack three meals!

2020-21 Kindergarten Registration Information

Kindergarten registration will begin on January 6, 2020 for those students who will be entering Kindergarten in the Fall of 2020. The student must turn **5 years old on or before August 1, 2020** in order to register. There is a waiver process for children with a birthdate after August 1st up to September 1st. The Kindergarten Academy your student will attend is determined by your residence only and not where other siblings may be attending. 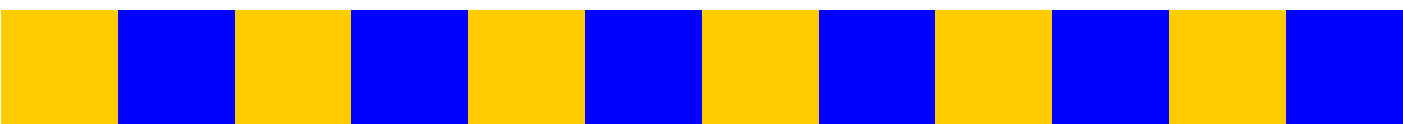
