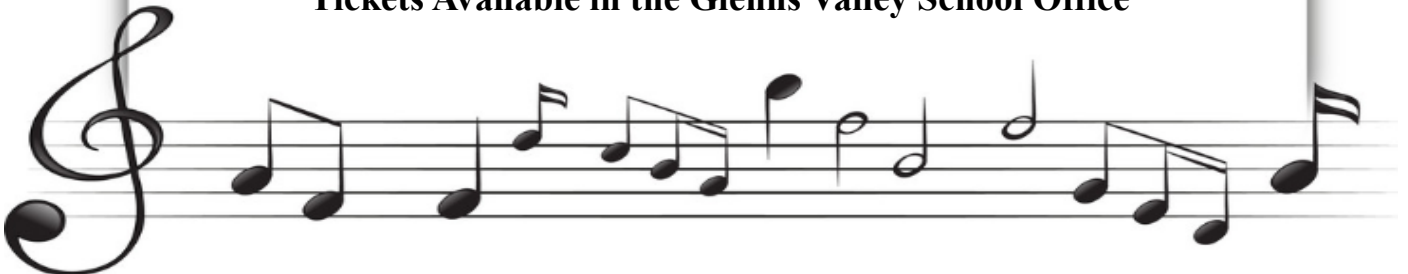
IMPD will be at Glenn's Valley on March 19 & 20th for the Body Safety Program.

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2020-21 Kindergarten Registration Information

Kindergarten registration will begin on January 6, 2020 for those students who will be entering Kindergarten in the Fall of 2020. The student must turn **5 years old on or before August 1, 2020** in order to register. There is a waiver process for children with a birthdate after August 1st up to September 1st. The Kindergarten Academy your student will attend is determined by your residence only and not where other siblings may be attending. Perry Township 2020 Summer Swim Program



It is that time again to begin thinking about signing your children up for a summer swim program. The Perry Township Summer Swim Program will be conducting summer swim classes for students ages 3 and up. Summer Swim 2020 will be held at **Perry Meridian High School**.

Two 2-week sessions are offered during summer. Each class meets for **50 minutes** Monday through Friday for a two-week session. An evening session is also offered at each session. The cost is **\$70.00** per child, which includes a t-shirt (based on time of sign-up). The **Parent/Toddlers Class (ages 6 month - 36 month)** is **\$60.00** and is offered for **30 minutes**.
