

STAYING SAFE

On October 1st and 2nd, 2020 IMPD will be putting on a virtual safety program to educate students on body safety. The IMPD Body Safety Program is an important educational tool for children. It is a community service provided by the Victim Assistance Unit of the Indianapolis Metropolitan Police Department and is presented in the majority of Marion County Schools. The IMPD Body Safety Presentations will be held virtually for in-person Student instruction only. This is a safety precaution in effect due to Covid-19 for the 2020-2021 school year. This prevention program empowers children to protect themselves and encourages them to tell a trusted adult if they have been a victim of child sexual assault. Presentations are adapted to the age and interest level of the children. IMPD has found that this program also helps cut down on many, common discipline problems involving inappropriate touch in Marion County Schools. An informational flyer with more information will be sent home with students closer to the presentation dates.
