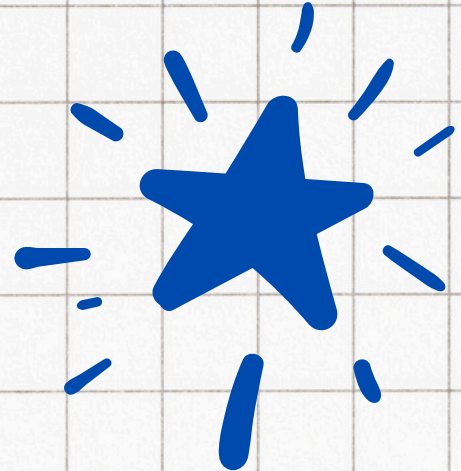

### 2025-2026 Kindergarten Registration Information

Kindergarten registration will begin on January 6, 2025 for those students who will be entering Kindergarten in the Fall of 2025. The student must turn 5 years old on or before August 1, 2025 in order

to register. There is a waiver process for children with a birthdate after August 1st up to August 15th. Contact the school for information. The Kindergarten Academy your student will attend is determined

by your residence only and not where other siblings may be attending. To determine which Kindergarten Academy your child will attend, please go to the Perry Township website at [perryschools.org](http://perryschools.org). Go to the For Parents tab, click on Enrollment, and Boundary Map.



## Sixth Grade Immunizations

All students entering 6th Grade are **REQUIRED** to get immunizations or boosters for the following vaccines:

- Tdap, (tetanus, diphtheria, pertussis)
- MCV, (meningitis)



**These are REQUIRED to enter 6th grade. Failure to get these immunizations may result in your student being excluded from school.**

### THE RISKS OF WHAT YOU MAY THINK IS JUST A HARMLESS LITTLE RASH



Symptoms of measles can be very dangerous to infants

#### Symptoms can include:

- Cough, runny nose, or red, watery eyes
- High fever
- A rash will occur 3 to 4 days after symptoms appear



#### How serious are the measles?

- Hospitalization occurs to 1 out of every 4 people who get measles
- Brain swelling due to infection (encephalitis), may lead to brain damage to 1 out of every 1,000 people with measles
- Even with the best care, 1 or 2 out of 1,000 people who have measles will die



Why is the measles vaccine so important?



#### It is the key to protecting your child.

- Measles cases are higher than they have been in the last 50 years, and the upward trend is expected to continue.
- Check with your health care provider to see if you need the measles vaccine and get the measles-mumps-rubella (MMR) vaccine for your children in accordance with the CDC recommended immunization schedule.

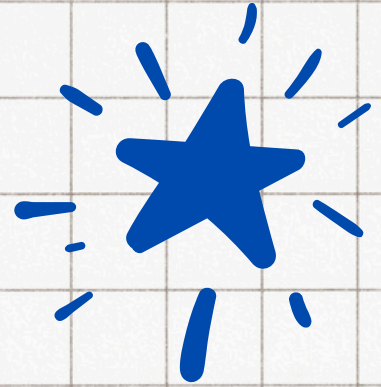

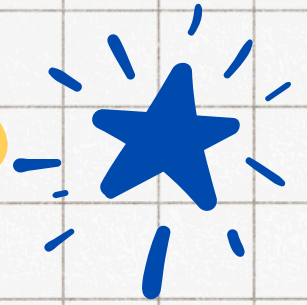

We are so proud of our Student Council and their families for getting up on a Saturday morning and packing 7,128 meals at Pack Away Hunger!



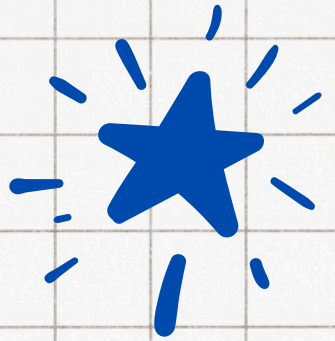
