#### 2025-2026 Kindergarten Registration Information

Kindergarten registration will begin on January 6, 2025 for those students who will be entering Kindergarten in the Fall of 2025. The student must turn 5 years old on or before August 1, 2025 in order

to register. There is a waiver process for children with a birthdate after August 1 st up to August 15th. Contact the school for information. The Kindergarten Academy your student will attend is determined

by your residence only and not where other siblings may be attending. To determine which Kindergarten Academy your child will attend, please go to the Perry Township website at perryschools.org. Go to the For Parents tab, click on Enrollment, and Boundary Map.

# Sixth Grade **Immunizations**

All students entering 6th Grade are REQUIRED to get immunizations or boosters for the following vaccines:


- Tdap, (tetanus, diphtheria, pertussis)
- MCV, (meningitis)

These are REQUIRED to enter 6th grade. Failure to get these immunizations may result in your student being excluded from school.


