Thank you for joining us for our Veterans Day Celebration today. Despite some technical difficulties our students enjoyed performing for you and I know that they now have a better understanding of the important role our veterans play in our country. Thank you for your patience today!

RPKA will hold our Body Safety program next week. Each year the Indiana Department of Education requires all schools to provide age appropriate instruction on body safety and child abuse prevention to students in Kindergarten through grade 12. According to state law, all students, K-12, must receive this education by December 15th each year. In accordance with this legislation on Tuesday, November 12, our SEL team will present the Unsafe/Safe Touch Program to our students at RPKA. There will be a series of age-appropriate videos shown during this presentation. This Body Safety program is an important part of your child's educational experience. 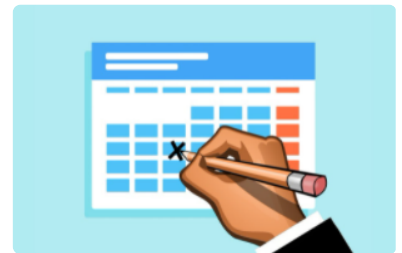

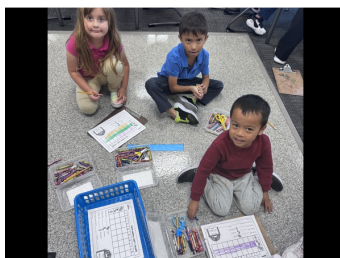
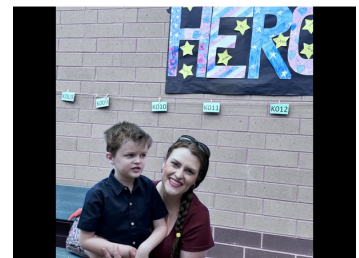
