
Please be sure your child wears a warm coat, hat, and gloves each day. We will be playing outside for recess weather permitting.

Intra-distrtict Transfer Request Information

INTRA-DISTRICT TRANSFER REQUESTS FOR THE 2025-2026 SCHOOL YEAR

For elementary and incoming kindergarten students currently living in Perry Township, IntraDistrict Transfer applications will be accepted January 6-February 7, 2025. Applications will only
be accepted after this period from families that are new to Perry Township. Acceptance letters
will be mailed to households after March 14, 2025. If a parent chooses not to accept the Intradistrict transfer for the 2025-2026 school year, they must notify the office of Assistant
Superintendent for Foundational Learning at The Perry Township Education Center no later than
April 11, 2025. Each Kindergarten Academy will be able to accept up to 20 transfer students.
Intra-District Transfers are good for as long as you are in the school. A new form will need to
be submitted when going into the 6th grade, or from kindergarten into 1th grade. Current
transfer students do not need to complete a new form. Requests must be turned into the
requested school by February 7, 2025.
