Kindergarten registration will begin on January 6, 2025 for those students who will be entering Kindergarten in the Fall of 2025. The student must turn 5 years old on or before August 1, 2025 in order to register. There is a waiver process for children with a birthdate after August 1 st up to August 15th. The Kindergarten Academy your student will attend is determined by your residence only and not where other siblings may be attending. 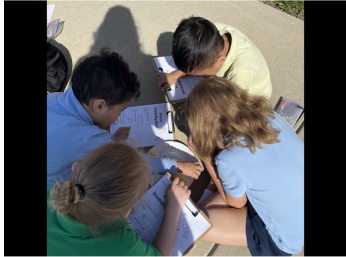
