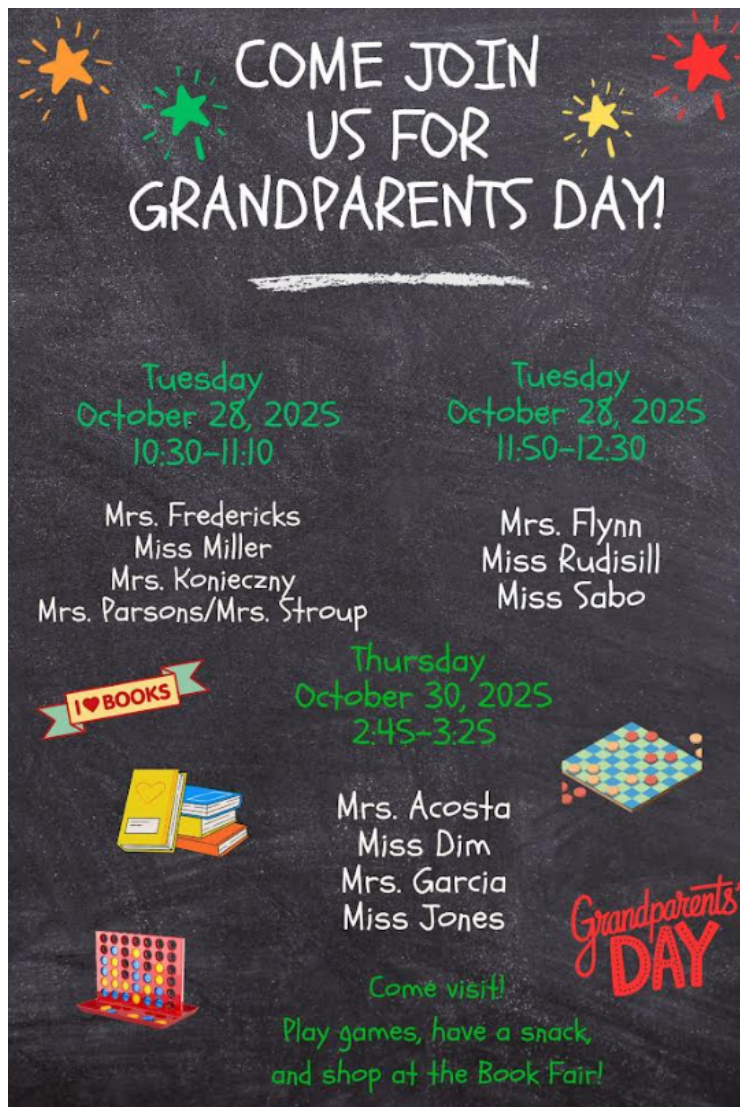

**News from our NUTRITION DEPARTMENT**

Perry Township Schools Nutrition Department, Cafe Express, offers options for special dietary needs.

Under the National School Lunch Program and USDA guidelines, Perry Township Schools are required to provide reasonable meal modifications to accommodate students who are unable to eat the school meal as is, at no additional charge, due to a disability, impairment and/or medical necessity (i.e. food allergy) that restricts their diet.

To request special meal accommodations, parents/guardians must complete the "Special Dietary Needs" form located on the district website under the "Child Nutrition Department" Special Dietary Needs section. Completed forms will be sent to and reviewed by the Assistant Child Nutrition Director.

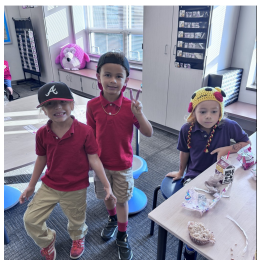

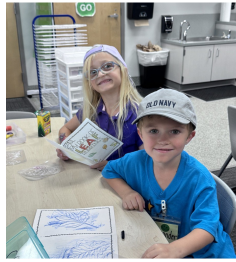
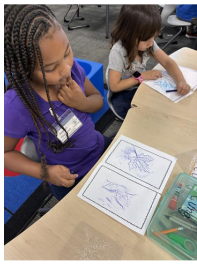
