

Notice of Public Meeting

The Board of Education of Perry Township Schools will hold a public meeting on Tuesday, June 27, 2017 at 6:00 p.m. at the Perry Township Education Center located at 6548 Orinoco Ave., Indianapolis, Indiana, to discuss and hear public comments including objections to and support for the proposed terms in the employment contract between the Board and the Superintendent of Schools.

The proposed terms include the following details:

1. Duration starting on July 1, 2017 and concluding on June 30, 2020, with automatic extension unless notice given;
2. Duties defined including the normal functions of a public school superintendent and as enumerated in policy;
3. Salary of \$198,000.00 with an annual increase not to exceed \$20,000.00 depending upon the results of the Superintendent's evaluation;
4. A contribution of \$1,538.46 split between Code Section 403(b) and 457 plans per pay period;
5. Contribution to the Indiana State Teacher's Retirement Fund that would otherwise be required to be paid by the Superintendent;
6. Appropriate business and professional expense payments including the cost of membership and participation in professional associations of school leaders, community organizations, and expenses related to the Superintendent's attendance at appropriate conferences and activities;
7. Any uninsured cost of an annual, routine medical-physical examination.
8. Additional basic salary of \$1,000.00 a month in lieu of an auto allowance or mileage reimbursement.
9. Access to the life insurance, long-term disability insurance, health and hospitalization insurance, dental insurance, vision insurance and other benefit plans offered to other employees. Superintendent may not be required to pay the required premiums to participate in selected plans.
10. Monthly technology allowance of \$100.00.
11. All leave equivalent to other full time administrative employees. Superintendent will receive no less than twenty (20) vacation days per year.
12. Any other fringe benefit available to other certified administrative employees, to teachers through the Master Contract, or other benefits which teachers of public school corporations are entitled under the law.
13. Provisions regarding evaluation and termination process consistent with the law; and
14. Miscellaneous provisions regarding non-monetary aspects of the contract.

The Board anticipates taking final action on this contract at a public meeting on or after Monday, July 10, 2017 at 6:30 p.m. at the Perry Township Education Center.
