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Legal Residency Regulations and Verification July, 2020

Legal Residency Regulations

The Indiana Department of Education has implemented a state statute for Legal Residency issues for all public school corporations, in accordance with I.C. 20-18-2-11. In most cases, legal settlement is determined by where the student's parent lives. I.C.20-26-11-2. Due to a variety of family circumstances, students may not have legal settlement where the parent, or custodial parent resides.

Documentation for Residency Verification

- 1. Parent/guardian must provide a piece of official mail in the parent/guardian's name and at an address in the Perry Township Schools boundary. "Official mail" can include a current utility bill or service agreement (gas, electric, water, cable), medical bill, insurance documentation, employment information, bank statement, mail from an official assistance agency or other official government office.
- 2. Parent/guardian can provide a purchase agreement/closing statement for a recently purchased home. (Recent will be defined as within the past 30 days) The parent/guardian who rents property can submit a current, valid lease. This type of document must be in the parent/guardian's name and at an address in the Perry Township Schools boundary.
- 3. The School Social Worker or designated school representative may conduct a home visit to verify residency.
