COMMUNITY ELIGIBILITY PROVISION

Perry Township Schools will continue to participate in the national school lunch and breakfast program called the **Community Eligibility Provision** (CEP) for the 25-26 school year. Through the CEP, all students will receive a healthy breakfast and lunch at school at no charge to the student. À la carte food purchases and additional meals are not included in this program and will incur a charge. When a student's account has a negative balance, no charges will be allowed for à la carte items.

PAYMENT PROCESS

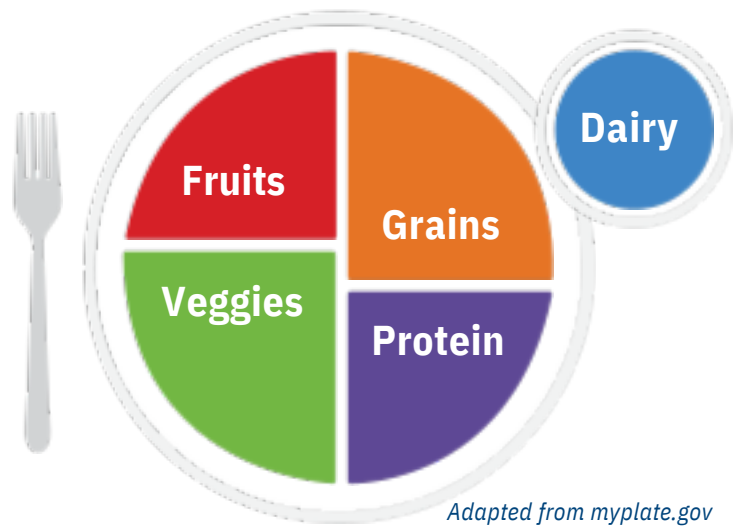
All students have a school meal account for pre-payments that is to be used for à la carte purchases in the cafeteria during the 25-26 school year. To make a payment, choose an option below:

- 1 To pay online by using e-Funds, by logging into perryschools.org. Select Lunch/Fee payment link at the top right of the screen, and log in to e-Funds for schools.
- 2 You may send cash or check to the school cafeteria. If you send a check or cash with your child, you **MUST** place it in a sealed envelope and write your child's complete name, student ID number, and amount enclosed in the envelope. No change will be given at the register.
- 3 Call 317-789-3738 or 317-789-3741 to submit your payment by phone, using your credit card.

FAMILY ASSISTANCE APPLICATIONS

At Perry Township Schools we strive to provide access and resources that benefit all students. Although meals and textbooks are free this year, we HIGHLY encourage families to still fill out the application on Skyward. Completing this application ensures the district receives all eligible funding to support students. Families who feel they qualify based on the income eligibility chart below should apply. Applications will open **August 11, 2025**. Please fill out an application before **September 1**. For the most rapid processing of your assistance application, please apply on Skyward.

TEXTBOOKS

Perry Township Schools will not charge families for textbooks for the 2025-26 school year. However, outstanding charges from previous years will still be billed. Additionally, any lost or damaged materials will be billed. Both of these payments can be paid through our e-Funds system.

MEDICATIONS

PRESCRIPTION MEDICATIONS

- Parent or guardian must sign medication consent form in advance
- Must have the physician's prescription label on the container
- Original and most up-to-date container

OVER THE COUNTER MEDICATIONS

- Must be in original container
- Must have dosing information on package
- Must be age appropriate (i.e., not adult Tylenol for a child)
- Parent or guardian must sign consent for school to administer

To carry medications at school, the student must have:

- Written documentation from physician of the medical condition and validation that student understands medicine use and misuse
- Medication consent form signed by parent or guardian

TRANSPORTING MEDICATIONS

- **For grades K-8:** A parent or guardian must transport medications to/from school per school board policy 5330.
- **For grades 9-12:** Students may transport their own medications with signed parental consent.

HepB: The minimum age for the third dose of Hepatitis B is 24 weeks of age.

DTaP: Four doses of DTaP/DTP/DT are acceptable if fourth dose was administered on or after the fourth birthday.

Polio*: Three doses of Polio are acceptable for all grade levels if the third dose was given on or after the fourth birthday and at least six months after the previous dose.

*For students in grades K-12, the final dose must be administered on or after the fourth birthday and be administered at least six months after the previous dose.

Varicella: Physician documentation of disease history, including month and year, is proof of immunity for children entering preschool through 12th grade. Parent report of disease history is not acceptable.

Tdap: There is no minimum interval from the last Td dose.

MCV4: Individuals who receive their first dose on or after their 16th birthday only need one dose of MCV4.

Hepatitis A: The minimum interval between first and second dose is six calendar months. Two doses are required for all grade levels.
